Dr. Abernathy writes in his book *And the Walls Came Tumbling Down*, that Dr. King wanted the Poor Peoples Campaign to begin at the end of the world, in Marks, Mississippi. And so it did. Even though Dr. King was assassinated on April 14, 1968, his inspired Mule Train left Marks on May 14, 1968. The 1,000 mile journey took a month to complete but 28 wagons pulled by 56 mules paraded down Pennsylvania Avenue on Juneteenth (June 19) 1968 as the centerpiece of the Poor Peoples Campaign. The Mule Train fulfilled one of Dr. King's dreams.
