In the earliest printed editions, it was usually called *De re coquinaria* (On the Subject of Cooking), and attributed to an otherwise unknown Caelius Apicius, an invention based on the fact that one of the two manuscripts is headed with the words *API CAE* or rather because a few recipes are attributed to Apicius in the text: *Patinam Apicianam sic facies* (IV, 14) *Ofellas Apicianas* (VII, 2). It is also known as *De re culinaria*.
